

I want to learn to SCUBA. Now what?

Well first a few things.

You must be in reasonably fit and be able to swim 220 yards or snorkel 300 yards. If you're still with me then you will need to do academics, pool work, and open water dives. You will be required to fill out a waiver and medical questionnaire like any other physical activity.

Now it's time for class & pool.

- Here at Abyss Scuba we give you the option of doing a NAUI or PADI academic course.
- Everything is included. You will receive mask, snorkel, fins, booties, scuba bag, educational material, **which are all yours to keep**. Pool sessions include tanks weights, jackets for your use, the only thing you need to bring is a towel and a smile.
- Cost is \$850.00
- In pool classes will be held at **Willowbrook Swim and Tennis** 6/26, 6/28, and 6/30 1:00-3:00 pm. E-learning must be completed prior to pool work.
- Classes are open to kids 10-18. Maximum 8 students per class. Minimum 5 students to run the class.

And now it's time for certification.

- Once you have completed the academic and pool work you will need to do 4 dives in "open water conditions".
- There are several options for completing these dives:
 - The cost of doing four certification dives is \$525 in a group class. This includes rental gear, entry fee to Dutch Spring recreational park, light faire on Saturday, instructor fees and processing of your card
 - Private open water dives can be scheduled and the cost is \$725.
 - We also arrange trips to various locations from Florida week end get a ways to more exotic locations where you can do your certification dives.
 - Or you may all ready have planned a trip. We will process all your referral paper work make copies for safe keeping and coordinate with you instructor at the location you are going to. We can also provide rental gear if you wish to use the equipment you got familiar with in the pool.

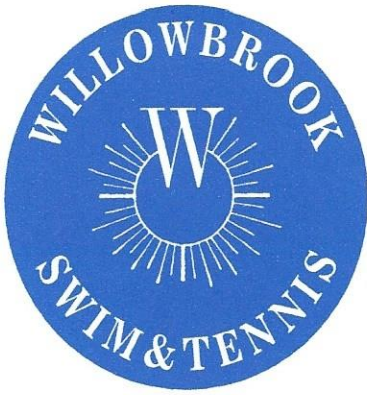
At this point any student 10 – 18 will be Jr. Open Water Certified with two important restrictions. You will enjoy the first 40 feet from the surface and will have to share the experience with an adult. Any diver 15 years or older is now certified to dive without direct supervision. So let's get wet and have some fun.
